Term of appointment

The term of these appointments will be from January 2018 through to conclusion of 2021 World Championships campaign in volunteer roles. A review of each appointed person will transpire annually undertaken by BA's Head of Wheelchair Basketball Program and the Head Coach of the Rollers.

Roles and Responsibilities

Working with the Head Coach of the IWBF U23 Men Team, who will be responsible for:

- Working with the Head of Wheelchair Basketball for BA, to set the 2-year program leading up to the IWBF World Championships.

The roles will be clarified as part of the interview process following successful application. You will have already had experience in this type of role, either within your club system or the State networks and have a good knowledge of the role you are applying for.

These are part-time national squad roles, to work within the Basketball Australia High Performance team, with a group of developing and emerging U23 men junior wheelchair basketball athletes for the 2021 World Championships campaign.

Basketball Australia will pay all reasonable travel, accommodation and meals while involved in the program camps and preparing for the World Championships.

If the successful staff members happen to be injured when involved in national team activities, such injury will be covered under BA's sports injury insurance policy.
