



Australian Under 18 3x3 2018 Youth Olympic Games Team Expressions of Interest – Coach

Basketball Australia is calling for Expressions of Interest for the position of Coach of the Australian Under 18 Women's team to compete in the 2018 Youth Olympic Games. The term of appointment will be from September 1, 2018 to October 31, 2018 and will include the 2018 Youth Olympic Games, to be held in Buenos Aires, Argentina October 6-18.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Coach of the Australian Under 18 Women's 3x3 Youth Olympic Games (YOG) team will be responsible for:

- Assisting in the technical preparation and planning for the team
- Technical leadership on style of play and appropriate 3x3 tactics and strategies
- Attendance at any preparation camps and games as required
- Attendance at any Australian Olympic Committee YOG team staff training activities
- Supervision of selected athletes during travel to the YOG
- Assist AOC staff in the supervision and welfare management of the selected athletes for the duration of the YOG
- Liaison with AOC staff in the YOG village in the areas of injury management and recovery

The Coach will work at the direction of the Basketball Australia Head of High Performance Coach Development. The team will consist of four athletes and the Coach will be the sole appointed staff member. Support services for athletes will be provided as part of the overall AOC YOG team.

Desired Experience and skill set –

- Demonstrated experience coaching 3x3 basketball
- Understanding of international 3x3 basketball
- Coaching experience at Australian Junior Championships
- Actively coaching in the BA NPP or State Performance Programs
- High level pastoral care skills and experience with athlete welfare management

Remuneration

This is a voluntary role, with all associated travel, accommodation and meals provided for the duration of the Youth Olympic Games.

If the Coach is injured when involved in national team activities, such injury will be covered under BA's sports injury insurance policy.
